

Buckhead DXO Track Replacement



project information

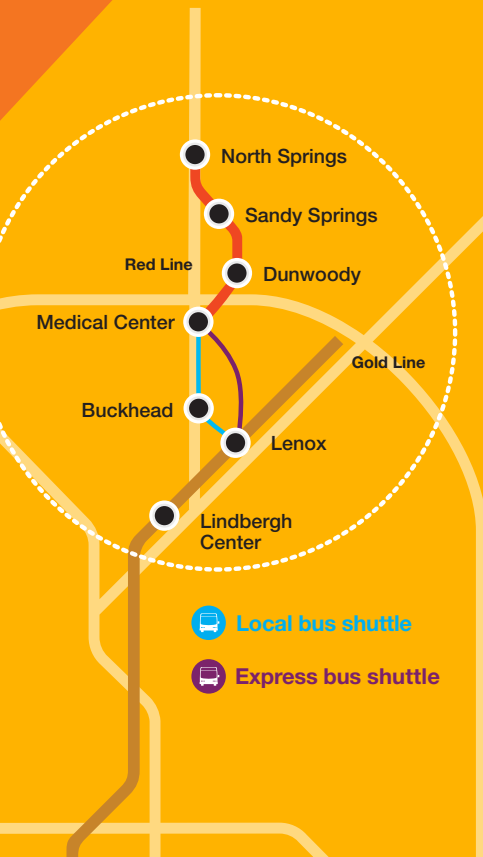
- This project requires a temporary suspension of rail service on the Red Line south of Medical Center Station for approximately 5 days.
- The upcoming work will be done on the Red Line between Buckhead and Medical Center Stations.
- Track Replacement Phase 4 (TR-IV) is an approximately \$225-million-dollar State of Good Repair project to replace aging track and switches throughout MARTA's rail system.
- This section of track includes a diamond crossover (DXO) which touches both main line tracks, preventing us from using normal single-tracking operations.

Bus shuttles will connect riders free of charge between Medical Center, Buckhead, and Lenox Stations.



- Local bus shuttles will make all station stops between Medical Center, Buckhead, and Lenox Stations.
- Express bus shuttles will operate non-stop between Medical Center Station and Lenox Station.

additional information:

- MARTA Station Agents and Transit Ambassadors will be at impacted stations to assist customers.
- Additional signage will be installed to guide customers between the bus shuttles and trains.
- Red Line customers are advised to allow additional time to travel through the work zone.
- A \$10 Uber or Lyft voucher for travel from affected stations will be provided through MARTACONnect that customers may use twice daily to supplement their transportation needs.
